- How to reach Okhla Bird Sanctuary:
- The sanctuary is located on the Delhi-Noida border, making it easily accessible by road or public transport. The closest metro station is the New Ashok Nagar metro station (Blue Line), just a 10-minute drive. Ola, Uber & Auto are available from the New Ashok Nagar metro station.
- For those driving, parking is available near the sanctuary entrance. Please plan to arrive 15 minutes early to ensure a timely start for the walk.

Weather Conditions

The weather at Okhla Bird Sanctuary in early October is generally warm and pleasant, with early morning temperatures ranging from **22°C to 28°C**. The monsoon freshness lingers, leaving the wetlands lush and vibrant. Early mornings are the best time to enjoy bird activity and nature walks.

- Pause at a scenic spot for group discussion.
- Insights into bird ecology, habitat conservation, and challenges.
- Interactive Q&A with the walk leader.

9:30 – 9:50 AM | Observation & Photography

- Explore additional habitats within the sanctuary.
- Photography opportunities and extended bird observation.
- Tips on mindful watching and bird-friendly gardening.

9:50 – 10:00 AM | Wrap-up & Group Photo

- Final reflections and participant takeaways.
- Group photo and short feedback session.
- Light refreshments served.
